What is a campus tour?

A campus tour is an opportunity for a student (and his or her parents) to visit a college campus he or she is interested in attending to check out the campus and other accommodations in person.

What does a campus tour include?

A campus tour typically includes an opportunity for a prospective student to take a tour of the campus/dorms, sit in on a class, talk with an admissions and financial aid counselor, visit with a department he or she may be interested in studying, try the cafeteria food, attend a campus event such as a sporting event or fine arts performance, etc. You may want to ask if you can do each of these things when visiting the campus.

How early should I schedule a campus tour?

Campus tours should be arranged 1-2 weeks in advance. Most campus tours are usually given Monday-Friday during normal office hours (around 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.)
