**The purpose** of this award is to recognize professional school counselors, educators, community members, or counselor educators who have been involved in sponsoring outstanding human rights projects or activities, which may include, but are not limited to:

- Stereotyping or discrimination
- Counseling, as a right of all students
- Elimination of abuse or neglect
- Elimination of service or program censorship
- Rights of the child
- Alcohol and drug abuse
- School dropouts
- Teenage pregnancy
- Cultural awareness
- Aids

To get us thinking more clearly about Human Rights, it might be helpful to read the following items taken from the United Nation's Universal Declaration of Human Rights:

**Preamble** Whereas recognition of the inherent dignity and of the equal and inalienable rights of all members of the human family is the foundation of freedom, justice and peace in the world,

**Article 1** All human beings are born free and equal in dignity and rights. They are endowed with reason and conscience and should act towards one another in a spirit of brotherhood.

**Article 2** Everyone is entitled to all the rights and freedoms set forth in this Declaration, without distinction of any kind, such as race, colour, sex, language, religion, political or other opinion, national or social origin, property, birth or other status.
